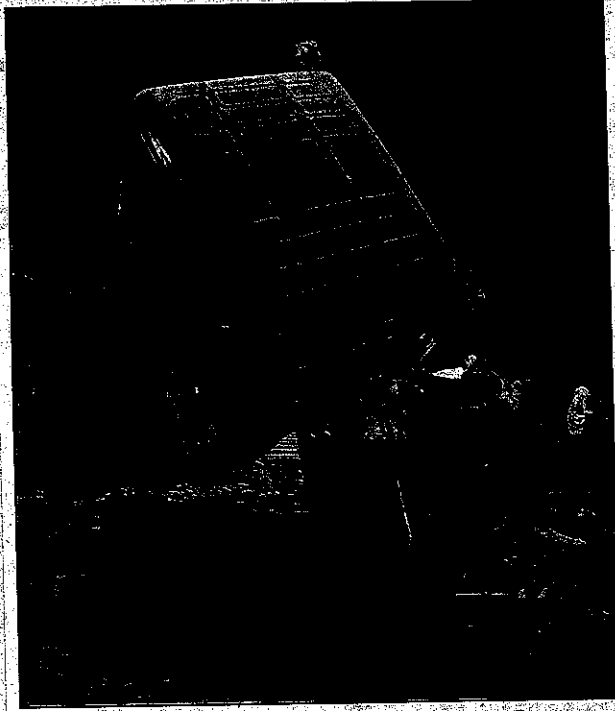


Man killed as truck over car, catches

'Natural for child to not want to recall trauma'

NEW DELHI: It is "highly natural" for a child to not want to recall the trauma of sexual assault and give varying accounts of the ordeal, a Delhi court said today while convicting a man of raping his 12-year-old neighbour, despite her changing statements.

The observation is in line with medical and on-ground findings, said experts, welcoming the judgment. "Any child who has undergone such a traumatic experience would not like to recapitulate the incident as it would be much

more traumatic and can even go a step forward to damage her psyche in future," said the court.

The judge said it was only after sustained questioning that the girl said she gave varying accounts because she never wanted to remember the incident.

Clinical psychologist Dr Pulkit Sharma for Imago Centre for Self, said, "Most victims, when they undergo trauma, disassociate themselves from the event. That's why they don't have a very coherent recollection of such crimes."

The court convicted one Ashok Jha on the basis of medical reports that confirmed rape.

NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND REMOTE E-VOTING INFORMATION

NOTICE is hereby given that:

(1) The next Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company will be held at **Sri Sathya Sai International Centre, Pragati Vihar, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110 003 on Friday, September 25, 2015 at 11.00 A.M.** to transact the Ordinary and Special Business, as set out in the Notice of AGM.

Notice convening the AGM, together with the Statement under Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') and the Annual Report & Accounts of the Company for FY 2014-15 have been dispatched to the Members of the Company at their registered address in the permitted mode. The dispatch of Notice of AGM and Annual Reports & Accounts has been completed on August 28, 2015.

The said notice of AGM and the Annual Report has been sent through e-mail on August 31, 2015 to the members who have opted to receive documents through electronic mode. These are also available on the corporate website of the Company viz. www.htmedia.in. However, any member who wishes to have a physical copy of the Notice /Annual Report may write to the Company's RTA at einward.ris@karvy.com.

(2) Pursuant to Section 91 of the Act read with Rule 10 of the Companies Act (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, the **Register of Members and Share Transfer Books of the Company shall remain closed from Friday, September 18, 2015 to Friday, September 25, 2015 (both days inclusive)** to determine the entitlement of the Members to the dividend declared at the AGM, if any. In respect of shares held in physical form, the dividend will be paid to those Members, whose name appears in the Register of Members as on Friday, September 25, 2015. In respect of shares held in electronic form, the dividend will be paid on the basis of beneficial ownership details provided by the depositories for the said purpose.

(3) In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Act read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, and Clause 35B of the Listing Agreement with Stock Exchanges, the Company is providing to its members, the facility to exercise their right to vote by electronic means on the Ordinary and Special Business set out in the Notice of AGM, through remote e-voting facility (i.e. facility of casting votes by using an electronic voting system from a place other than the venue of AGM). M/s Karvy Computershare Private Limited ('Karvy') has been engaged by the Company to provide remote e-voting facilities. The procedure for remote e-voting has been outlined in the Notice of AGM.

(a) Members of the Company holding shares in physical or Dematerialized form, as the case may be, on the cut-off date i.e. Friday, September 18, 2015, only are entitled to avail the facility to cast their vote by remote e-voting as well as voting in the AGM.

(b) The remote e-voting facility shall commence from Tuesday, September 22, 2015 (9.00 a.m. Server time) and remain open up to Thursday, September 24, 2015 (5.00 p.m. Server time). Thereafter, the remote e-voting module shall be disabled by Karvy. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by the member, the member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

(c) Further, the members who have exercised their right to vote through remote e-voting may participate in the AGM, but shall not be allowed to vote again thereat.

The Company is also providing facility for voting through polling paper which shall be available at the AGM; and members participating at the meeting who have not already exercised their right to vote through remote e-voting, shall be able to exercise the right to vote at the meeting.

Any person who becomes member of the Company after dispatch of the Notice of meeting and holding shares as on the cut-off date i.e. Friday, September 18, 2015 may obtain the User Id and Password by sending a request at evoting@karvy.com.
